Year 1 & 2 Animal Experience Visit

Dear Parent/ Carers,

As part of our Science week in February, we are pleased to announce that the KSI will be having an animal show and tell experience at Stoberry!

On Wednesday 12th March, the North Somerset Bird of Prey Outreach group will be in school to inspire the children with a show and tell of a range of different animal classifications including birds, mammals and reptiles. The children will be able to meet and learn about different animals up close in real life. The children can also touch and pass around exciting items linked to animals including feathers, raptor eggs, falconry gloves, snake skin and spider shed. They will learn about range of subjects such as nocturnal animals, predator/prey relationships, adaptations, habitats and life cycles.
