Y6 London Residential 2026

Tuesday 7th January 2025

Dear Parents/Carers,

It is our intention to take our Year 6 pupils on a residential visit to Marchants Hill, on the South Downs National Park, from <u>Monday 28th September to Friday 2nd October 2026</u>. This is a fantastic experience for the children every year, mixing outdoor and adventurous activities with an opportunity to also experience the bright lights of London.

We now need to start the process of confirming our booking with PGL and would therefore ask that a <u>non-refundable</u> initial deposit of £60 per child (£12 for pupil premium children) is paid on <u>Scopay</u> by <u>9am Friday 31st January 2025</u> in order to secure a place for your child.

The total cost of the trip will be £440.00 (£110 for Pupil Premium children), and includes travel by coach, full board accommodation, £20 spending money, a full programme of activities such as zip wire, trapeze, giant swing and a theatre, museum and Chessington excursion. PTA have given a donation towards this residential to help reduce the price for all families. Bedding is not included and the children will need to bring a sleeping bag and pillow with them.

Payment Schedule Information

Below are the dates when we would recommend payments are made. All payments must be received by 31st March 2026. If we have not received full payment by this date we will presume that you no longer wish for your child to take part. Please note that you may top up your account as often as you need, weekly, fortnightly etc to help you meet these timescales. We also need to reiterate that if you decide to pull your child out of the residential at any point that you will also lose any monies paid up to that point, unless of course there is documentation that could be used as evidence for an insurance claim. We also need to bring to your attention that if your child leaves Stoberry Park School, they will not be able to attend the residential and there will be no refund for monies paid. If you are having any difficulties meeting the payment deadlines at any time, please contact the school Admin Team who would be happy to discuss an individual payment plan with you.

The payments for this trip may be made using our online payment service at \underline{Scopay} . Please contact the School Office if you have lost your secure login details. You will find the link to Scopay on the front page of the school website under 'The Shop' section, next to the picture of Iggy the cat. You will need your login details and a debit/credit card to make the payment. If you would like your child to participate, please make the 1^{st} payment of £60 (£12 PP) on Scopay by $\underline{9am\ Friday\ 31^{st}\ January\ 2025}$. It will be possible to make future payments weekly or any way suitable to you as each payment deadline approaches.

As we are sure you are aware, residential courses organised by the school are an optional but invaluable part of the National Curriculum. We feel sure that the course we have chosen for this year group will prove to be a most worthwhile and enjoyable experience for those pupils concerned. If you have read, fully understood and are satisfied with details supplied about the trip and activities in this letter and agree to your child taking part at a total cost of £440.00 (£110 for Pupil Premium Children) which can be paid in instalments by the due dates listed previously, please give your consent on Scopay as this will act as your contract of commitment by 9am Friday 31st January 2025. Please understand that any payments made via Scopay will be non-refundable and if your child subsequently opts to not attend this trip the School will not be able to refund payments made unless documentation is provided that can be used for an insurance claim. I understand that staff reserve the right to send children home in cases of a contagious illness or where they are putting themselves/others at risk. In these situations, the parents must arrange for their child to be collected and no refund will be given, unless accepted through an insurance claim.

The school has Activities Insurance for students for all trips and activities on and off the school site. Details of the key benefits are available from the School Office. The School only provides cover at the School against proven or agreed negligence by its employees. Parents should consider taking out additional insurance cover for their child if they require benefits above those provided by the school.

To support the cost of the visit (we have already reduced the cost based on this idea) we are hoping that there might be some enthusiastic parents among you who would be willing to run a series of ice-cream sales on a Friday after school. The aim would be to sell ice-creams at a very affordable price for families, while raising money for the visit. Please let the school office know if you would be willing to help.
