SCOPAY/Worldpay/Communications update

Dear Parents and Carers,

We will shortly be moving away from Worldpay as our payment provider, meaning that parents will once again be able to pay through the SCOPAY app. The new payment provider will be VMS. We are aware that there are ongoing issues with both SCOPAY and Worldpay and hope this change will solve both of these issues. Please look out for updates, as we hope this will happen over the coming week or so. SCOPAY will remain our booking provider for SPARKS and lunches for the immediate future – see further details below.

From Monday 21st April (after the Easter holidays), our <u>parent.mail@stoberrypark.co.uk</u> email address will be changing to <u>parentcommunicationstp@acexcellence.co.uk</u> for all parent communications. Please use this email address in future for all communications intended for classroom staff from this date.

After the Easter break, we are also planning on moving to a new communications system for emails and SMS messages. This is making use of Bromcom, our new Information Management System in school. Over time, this will also be used for all bookings, visit permissions and payments, to replace Tucasi, Worldpay and Scopay.
