Dear Parent / Carer.

We have been very fortunate in being able to book 270 front of house seats in the stalls for the family-friendly theatre production of 'Jack and the Beanstalk' at The Bristol Hippodrome. We would like to make these tickets available to children who will be in Year 1 to Year 6 in the 2025/26 academic year on a first come, first served basis. This is not a curriculum-based trip but an opportunity to experience the excitement of live theatre and see a show packed with spectacular special effects, therefore full payment is required to secure a place. If we are unable to fill all the coaches, we may have to look at restricting numbers to fewer children.

We are able to offer tickets and transport at the price of £27.00 per child and the trip will take place on <u>Thursday 11th</u> <u>December, 2025.</u> Children will leave school at 11:00am and will return to school at approximately 6:30pm, with all things going to plan and the traffic in Bristol not being too bad!

In the event of the level of contributions not covering the costs we may have to unfortunately cancel the event. Contributions for this trip will need to be made via scopay.

To sign your child up, please complete your consent and payment on Scopay, which also acts as your permission and acceptance of the commitment stated below for your child to take part. You will find the link to Scopay on the front page of the school website under 'The Shop' section, next to the picture of Iggy the cat. The deadline for consent and payment is **Monday 30th June**.

Your child will need a packed lunch on the day. These can be ordered in the Autumn term.

Contract of commitment for 'Jack and the Beanstalk' trip
