Dear Parents/Carers

As part of our 'Animals' quest we are planning a trip to Court Farm (Wolvershill Rd, Banwell BS29 6DL) on Friday 16th May to find out more about farm animals. We hope the trip will help the children to get an insight into which animals live on a farm, what jobs the farmers have to do on a farm, as well as inspire writing and artwork as part of our quest topic for the term.

Activities the children will take part in during this visit will be:

Visiting a variety of farm animals, having the chance to touch and stroke some.

Watch cows being milked.

Bottle feeding lambs.

Going on a tractor trailer ride around the farm.

The coach will leave Stoberry Park School 9:15am and will return at 3:00pm depending on traffic.

Although we hope for fine weather can you ensure all children have:

- A named waterproof coat
- Wear trainers or wellies if wet
- School shirts
- School jumpers
- Leggings or jeans
- Plenty of drink will be required
- If it is sunny, can you please apply sun lotion before the children come to school and supply a named sun hat.

Throughout the farm there are lots of handwashing and hand sanitising stations to ensure that the children keep their hands clean whenever they have touched an animal. Staff will ensure that the children clean their hands regularly throughout the day especially before eating and drinking at snack / lunch times

At Stoberry Park School, the health, safety and wellbeing of every child is our top priority. We expect all staff, Governors, parent/carers and visitors to share this commitment to safeguarding our pupils.



Lunch and Payment

The total cost of the trip including entry and coach travel is £10.00, which includes a contribution from the FOSPS to help subsidise the cost of the trip. Children will need a packed lunch which can be provided by the school through the universal infant free school meal (UFSM) scheme.
