**Life skills trip**

Dear Parent/ Carers,

As part of our offering for year 6 children, we have secured a booking at The Create Centre in Bristol for a Life Skills session. This trip is planned for Y6s on **Wednesday 21st May**. Children will leave school at 8:15 and will return for the end of the school day.



Lifeskills aims to show pupils that they should be taking personal responsibility for their own safety. Children learn how to assess risk and cope with difficult situations by taking part in realistic, interactive activities. Volunteer Guides take small groups of children around the realistic "village" to experience a number of difficult or dangerous situations. Children must work together to decide how to overcome each problem and have the opportunity to learn from their mistakes in a safe environment.

As an extra addition to this trip for our Y6s, who will have sat their KS2 SATS, will then head up to Clifton Downs to have a picnic lunch together. Children should wear their normal school uniform - those children who have leavers hoodies are permitted to wear them on this day - and bring a packed lunch, coat and water bottle.

As part of fostering life skills with year 6, children will be fundraising in school to fund the cost of travel for this trip. Therefore, the cost of this trip will be £14 which will cover the cost of the session in Bristol.

Due to the school being committed to supporting pupils in receipt of Pupil Premium, we are pleased to be able to offer this trip at the discounted price of £7 for Pupil Premium pupils.

Clearly, for us to be able to run this event it will need to be financially viable and in the event of the level of contributions not covering the costs we will have to cancel this event.
